

ICC-ES has expanded its services and offers now a comprehensive **PMG Listing Program** covering all major codes and standards. Additionally, ICC-ES has developed the nation's first verification program evaluating the sustainability of product attributes (**SAVE Program**).

ICC-ES reports and listings are available free of charge to code officials, contractors, specifiers, architects, engineers, and anyone else with an interest in the building industry and construction.

The following webpage has been made available to jurisdictions, ICC Chapters, and organizations that would like to incorporate direct recognition of ICC-ES Evaluation Reports, the PMG Listing Program, and the SAVE Program into their existing website. The page has been designed to offer easy access to important information on the ICC-ES® website in reference to ICC Evaluation Service®.

The page uses JavaScript drop-down menus along with external links to specific areas of each ICC-ES Program along with a link to the ICC-ES homepage. At the time of availability, the site has been designed and tested to meet minimum accessibility requirements. This page has been laid out to be incorporated into an existing website while requiring minimal modifications.

General:

1. When you click the download button below a folder will be placed on your desktop that will include an html file and a folder of images named /webimages/.
2. The html document <ES_Webpage_Template_final.html> can be modified to incorporate the jurisdiction's logo and/or any building-type photographs as noted below.
3. All images are stored and linked in the /webimages/ folder. The /webimages/ folder will need to reside within the same directory as the html document on the web server. If the image location is changed, then the tags within the html document will need to be updated to indicate the new location.

Areas within the html document that require modification:

- A:** Line 141—**Link to Jurisdiction's Home Page**—Change the text and link here to your information.
- B:** Line 146—Replace image (8-62001-19.1.v3a.jpg) with a photo of building(s) or jurisdiction logo. Remember to include ALT text for any images.
- C–D:** Lines 147 and 148—**(Insert Jurisdiction Name)**—Put your jurisdiction name in these two places.
- E:** Line 150—**(Insert additional information about the jurisdiction and its use of evaluation reports to verify code compliance.)**—This may include any conditions used to accept reports and other additional information that may be required by the jurisdiction, or this may include external links to additional information.
