Subject: Private Label Listing Evaluation Reports

MEMO

The ICC-ES Rules of Procedure for Evaluation Reports were amended on July 30, 2007, to allow report holders to authorize the issuing of a separate evaluation report under the name of a product distributor. Such reports, known as private label evaluation reports, are inextricably linked to the evaluation report originally issued, and must remain identical to that report in all ways except the name of the report holder. Fees for new private label evaluation reports are the same as the basic fee for a one-year re-examination of an ICC-ES evaluation report without change. For details, see Sections 3.0 and 6.1.6 of the Rules of Procedure for Evaluation Reports, and Table 2 of the ICC-ES Fee Schedule.

We hope the new rules covering private label reports will be useful to report holders and to private label distributors of report holders' products.
